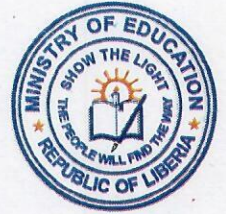

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (REOI)

Assignment Title: Technical Assistance for Developing WASSCE Tutorial and Testing System.

Background:

The Government of Liberia has received funding from the Performance-Based Condition component of the Global Partnership for Education project and intend to apportion part of this amount to develop a system to support all 12th graders for the West African Senior Secondary Examination (WASSCE) preparation, for the Ministry of Education.

Objective of assignment

The over-arching objective of the assignment is to develop an online automated Tutorial and Testing system for support all 12th graders to be used for the West African Senior Secondary Examination (WASSCE) preparation.

The Scope of Services / Expected Key Deliverables

The scope of the assignment includes but not limited to developing an online automated Tutorial System that has the following features:

- Contains pre-loaded lessons, test questions and automated scoring and reports.
- Equipped with statistics generator that reports various indicators, such as;
 - Information of Examinee
 - Geo-location
 - General required data fields such as personal info, school, subject of test, date, time, etc.
 - Scores by region, county, district, school
- Enabled user's self-login
- Enabled web security for system protection
- Enabled portal for loading of additional questions and answers
- Develop a system that incorporates module for self-pace learning
- Enabled mobile app

The Ministry of Education under the Department of Instruction with support from the Department of Administration will have the implementation responsibilities.

Duration and Timelines

The duration of contract will be for a period of four (4) months of as of the date of signing of the contract.

Short-listing firms' qualification or criteria are:

- A firm (s) must provide a valid tax clearance and business registration certificate
- Firm (s) expressing interest in the above should have at least 4 years working experience in delivery of software.
- Provide a secure platform using available security and firewall solutions with cloud-based system.
- Accessibility and redundancy in the case of disaster is demanded.
- Platform should be scalable for future enhancements and another workflows integration.
- Provide a friendly user environment for easy assimilation for non-IT knowledgeable staff.
- Provide onsite training for end users and advance training for IT management Staff.
- Provide minimum of 2 years quality service guarantee after deployment
- Must have developed online system that are in use in the last 5 years
- Must have developed similar system to the complexity in the last 3 years
- A signed and notarized listing of both the legal and beneficial owners of business

Key Staff Qualifications:

- A technical team of up to three key staff and two non-key staff with hands-on experience in developing online system systems (Platform.) for at least 5 years.
- Must be familiar with the Liberian context
- Experience in statistical analysis and formulation of assessment tools
- Strong analytical and technical skills in social science research design, management, analysis and reporting. Ideally, a balance of quantitative (including statistical) and qualitative research skills. Excellent research and communications skills, both written and oral, as demonstrated in previous works.
- Proven track record in working effectively within multidisciplinary teams and with international development partners.
- Two samples of applicable works appropriate to Liberia's context (assessment tool)
