The Government of Liberia has received a grant equivalent to USD 47 million from the International Development Association (IDA) to implement the Improving Results in Secondary Education (IRISE) Project, hereinafter “the Project”. The Project duration is four years. The Ministry of Education (MoE) is the IRISE implementation agency responsible for project execution and results monitoring. The implementation is overseen by the Ministry’s Senior Management Team (SMT). The Ministry of Education intends to apply part of the proceeds from the grant toward payments under the contract(s) for **Supply, Delivery and Installation of 160No. Laptop Computer and 160No. Printers for the Female Guidance Counselors Program under Sub-component 2.2 of the IRISE Project**. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank’s Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit.

 5. All Bidders should quote for both Item 1 and Item 2 in their Bid as a single Lot for a single contract. Any Bidder that quote for only Item 1 or 2 shall be treated as incomplete bid. A Bidder must as well demonstrate that it meets the qualification criteria for the supply, delivery and installation of both Items 1 and 2.
